The staff at Peter Burnett School strives to create a positive learning environment that encourages good citizenship, develops responsibility, and fosters fairness and respect for all. There is a “O” Tolerance Policy with regards to any bullying/harassment of others. This includes any type of bullying behaviors, harassment, intimidation, name calling, racial slurs, profanity, or gossiping. Keeping that in mind, we have created a tiered intervention plan for students found breaking our “O” Tolerance to Bullying Policy. The plan is as follows:

- 1st Offense – White Slip; Participation in behavior intervention program during recesses.
- 2nd Offense – White slip; Participation in behavior intervention program during recesses;
Miss 2 days of recess.
- 3rd Offense - White slip; Participation in behavior intervention program during recesses;
Miss 3 days of recess; Behavior Intervention Meeting with principal, parent(s),
and teacher.
- 4th Offense - White slip; Participation in behavior intervention program during recesses;
Behavior Intervention Meeting with principal, parent(s) and teacher;
In-House suspension – 2 days.
- 5th Offense - White slip; Participation in behavior intervention program during recesses;
Behavior Intervention Meeting with principal, parent(s), and teacher;
3 days suspension at home.
