RESPONSIBILITIES OF STUDENTS

4. Assume responsibility for my child's appropriate appearance.
5. Reinforce the rules of the school.
6. Provide a quiet place/time for my student to study.
7. Monitor my son/daughter's progress regularly. Talk with my child about his/her activities every day.
8. Limit my child's TV viewing.
9. Encourage my child to read by reading to him/her and by reading myself.
10. Discuss school rules and consequences for misbehavior with your child including reasons for suspension/expulsion as outlined in the Student Handbook (Education Code 48900).

RESPONSIBILITIES OF SCHOOL AND STAFF

1. Accept each child as a unique individual and respect his/her rights and property.
2. **Establish and maintain open communication between pupil, parent and staff to meet each pupil's needs.**
3. Establish and maintain rich and varied educational experiences.
4. Provide an environment which will create an atmosphere conducive to enthusiastic learning.
5. Provide a maximum of opportunities for the student to make judgments, assume responsibilities and develop self-discipline.
6. Provide supervision to insure the safety of all students.
7. Provide appropriate in-service and training for teachers and parents.
8. Explain goals, expectations and grading system to students and parents.
9. Review school rules and consequences for misbehavior with all students including reasons for suspension/expulsion as outlined in the Student Handbook (Education Code 48900).
